Dear KG2 Parents,

I know that the first "dictations" are difficult for some children and stressful for the parents. Please do not consider them as any kind of a test. This is just a review of what your child has practiced for the whole week. Your child is learning!- he/she might make mistakes, his/her handwriting might still be not as you wish. Please be patient and stay positive about homework. Tell your child how important the homework is. Ask to see your child's homework every day and discuss it with him/her. Be supportive.

## ☆ General Homework Tips ☆

Here are a few general homework tips for you:

- **Time**

Establish a set time each day for doing homework. Many kids need a break after school, while others like to start doing their homework right after getting back home. Find your child's best time and consistently reinforce it to make it part of his daily routine. The amount of time each child spends doing daily homework will vary depending on the amount of homework assigned and individual abilities of each child.

- **Study area**

Make sure your child has a quiet, well-lit place to do homework. Avoid having your child do homework with television on or in places with other distractions.

- **Supplies**

Keep supplies (pencils, rubbers, crayons, sharpener) in a basket or plastic container next to your child's study area.

- **Hard work, easy work**

Help your child figure what is hard work and what is easy work. Have your child do the hard work first. This will mean he will be most alert when facing harder assignments. Easy material will seem to go fast when fatigue begins to set in.

- **Your guidance.**

When your child asks for help, provide guidance, not answers. Giving answers means your child will not learn the material. Homework is a great way for kids to develop independent, lifelong learning skills. It is also a way to teach your child responsibility and self discipline.

- **Offer praise and reward progress.**

Be specific, say: "It's great to see you working so hard!". If your child has been successful in completing his homework assignments and working hard, celebrate that success with a special event.
